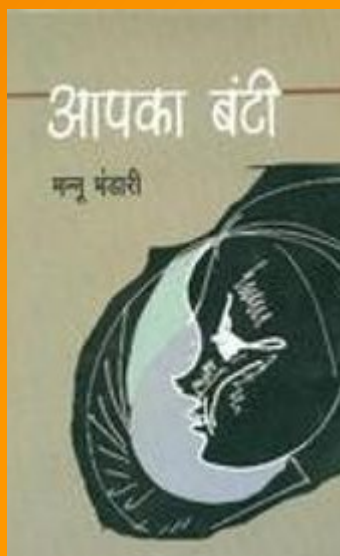

Complete set of records were prepared .On studying the case in detail it was found that the problem was mainly in the lower jaw as it was short. The patient was still in the growing age so growth modification was planned. It was decided to modify the growth of the mandible with a twin block appliance. The appliance was fabricated and the patient was instructed to wear the appliance full time. Good results were obtained as the patient was very co-operative and wore the appliance religiously .



Suggestive Reading ::

This novel raises issue of divorce and how the personality of children is churned as a consequence of the divorce of parents. It often happens that the divorced parents uses their child as a weapon against each other. The protagonist of the story, bunt, a nine year old child, is caught between the divorce of his parents. How he sees his world crumbling around him without having any idea of why is this happening, is very well portrayed by the author. At the end, it's nobody's fault, but that of circumstances, that make bunt a loved but unacceptable child. Author easily and very swiftly catches the nerve of the reader with her sensitive and emotional portrayal of the protagonist. A must read for readers who prefer this genre.
