

LIPOMA WITH A CARTILAGINOUS METAPLASIA: A RARE VARIANT





We report a case of chondrolipoma in a 35-year-old male patient presented with a painless mass on the posterior dorsal surface of tongue, present since 20 years. The lesion showed slow growth, with no increase in size for past many years associated with mild difficulty in swallowing. On Intraoral examination, the growth was nodular, oval in shape, sessile and well circumscribed, measuring approximately 1 x 1 cm in diameter. The overlying mucosa was pale and surface smooth. (Figure 1) Mass was firm in consistency with no tendernous or discharge.

Conservative surgical excision was done and on histopathological examination, tumor was composed of a well circumscribed mass of mature fat cells covered by stratified squamous epithelium containing small foci of hyaline cartilage within the tumor mass. (Figure 2) A confirmed diagnosis of chondrolipoma was made. This paper discusses the clinical and histopathological features of this rare variant of lipoma.


