

The program was followed by hands on and even a interactive question answer round by the students. The program was then followed by refreshments for Mrs. Shetty and the teaching Staff.



#### EXTRA GINGIVAL PYOGENIC GRANULOMA - A RARE CASE REPORT



Pre- Treatment





Pyogenic granuloma is relatively a common benign inflammatory hyperplasia that presents as a mucocutaneous lesion. Clinically, pyogenic granuloma presents as a smooth or lobulated exophytic lesion manifesting as small, red erythematous papules on a pedunclated or sometimes sessile base, which is usually hemorrhagic. We present a rare case of extra gingival pyogenic granuloma in a 40-year-old male patient who reported to our department with the chief complaint of growth on left buccal mucosa since one year. On intraoral examination, a well defined, smooth, lobulated, exophytic and pedunclated lesion was seen on the left buccal mucosa which was asymptomatic. Based on the history and clinical examination, a provisional diagnosis of traumatic fibroma was made. An excisional biopsy was performed which histopathologically revealed the lesion to be pyogenic granuloma. Patient was followed up after a week, one month and one year, and no recurrence of the lesion was seen.
