

Female patient Rohini of age 23 years came to the department of orthodontics with the chief complaint of forwardly placed teeth. The case was studied after taking the preliminary records. The records included complete sets of photographs, X- rays and study models. The detailed case history and patients expectation from the treatment was also were recorded. After preparing the problem list orthognathic surgery was planned for the patient. The case was started by putting a basic orthodontic fixed appliance for the patients. Before doing the surgery it was planned to decompensate the malocclusion the decompensation or the presurgical phase continued for nearly six months after which the surgery was done. The patient had to come to the department again for the postsurgical orthodontic phase. The post surgical orthodontic phase continued for another four months in which the minor correction in the occlusion were done. The overall result was very satisfying for the patient as well as the doctor's team. In this case the surgical correction was required to correct the skeletal discrepancy where as the dental correction was done with the orthodontic fixed appliance.
